someone was trying to keep out a creature!

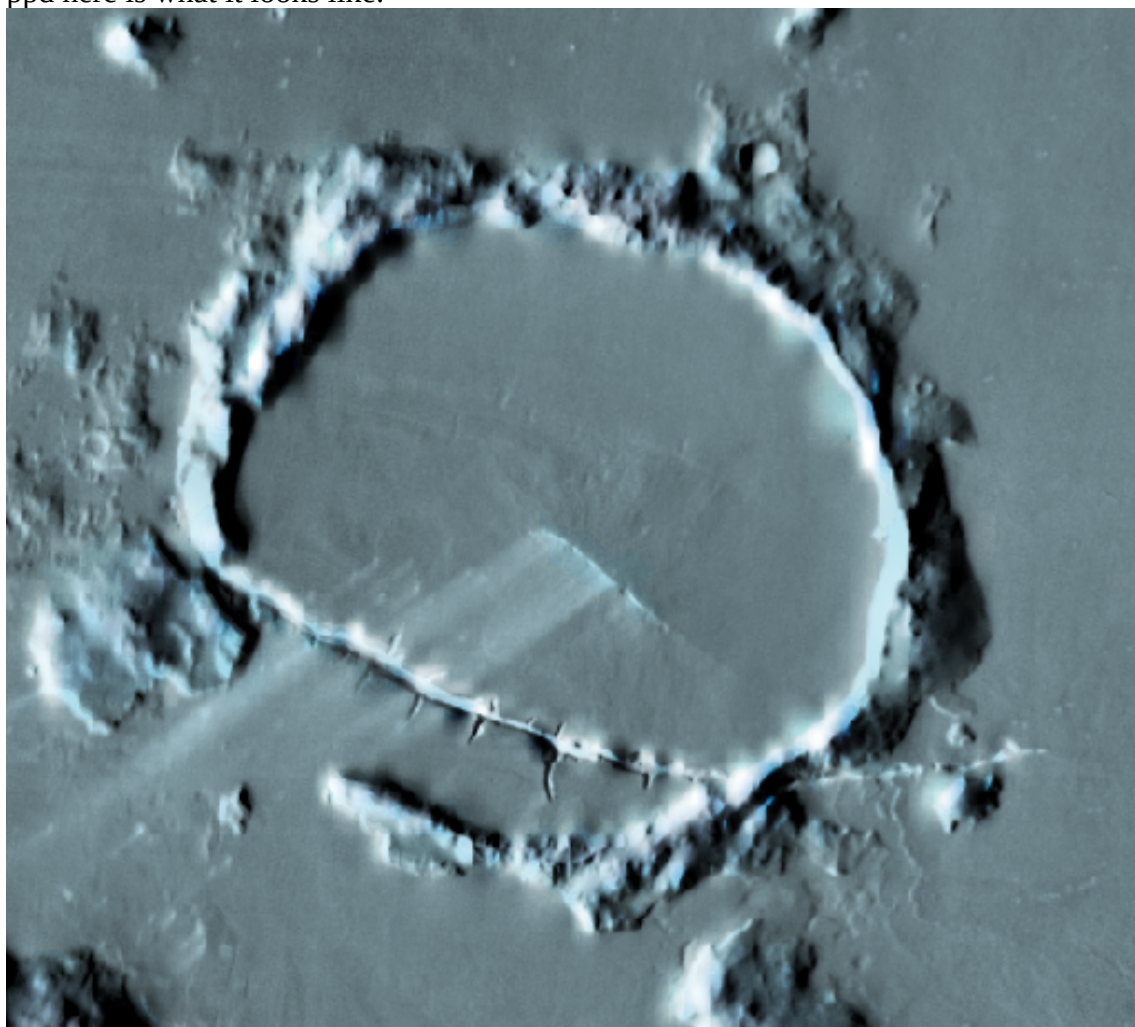

Solution: Our crater is at lon/lat 161.273E, 7.291. The fracture has been described as a barbed wire fence and the stitches of Frankenstein (<http://themis.mars.asu.edu/zoom-20050225039341a>).

At 512 ppd here is what it looks like:

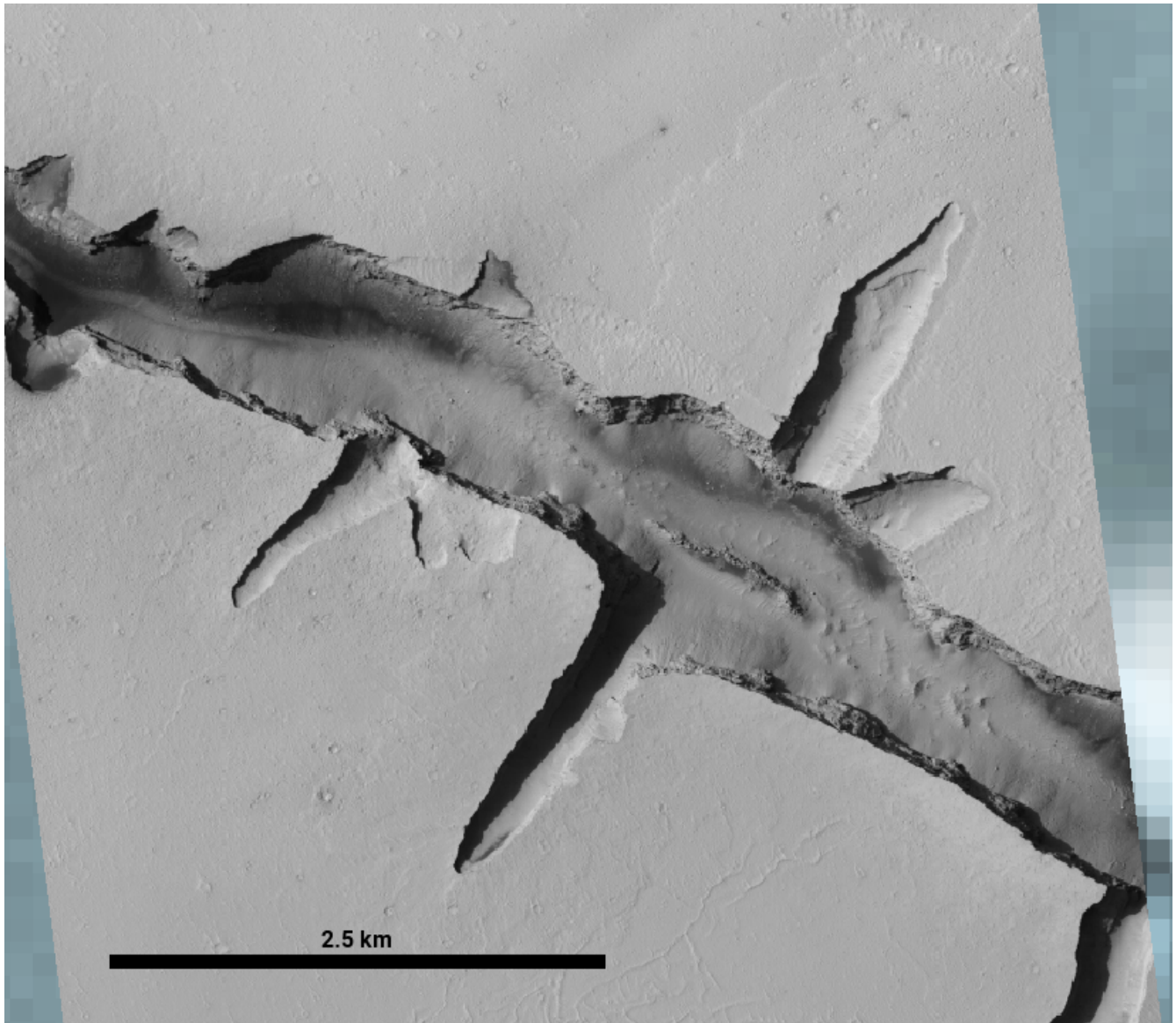
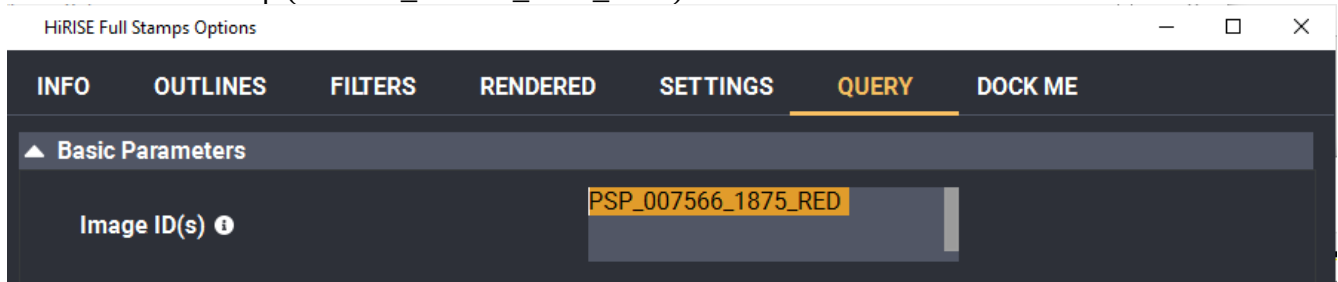
