

Zoom to 512 ppd to get a good view. Use THEMIS and HiRISE stamp over the feature, to get a great view! A detailed solution will follow!




Solution: Our crater is at lon/lat 161.273E, 7.291. The fracture has been described as a barbed wire fence and the stitches of Frankenstein (http://themis.mars.asu.edu/zoom-20050225039341a).

At 512 ppd here is what it looks like:





If we load a THEMIS stamp (ID: V13300013):
